Singing for Seniors was developed, based on global research, and designed specifically for the New Zealand aged care sector. Singing for Seniors offers programmes which cover the full continuum of care for any resident in your facilities. Voice and breathing exercises are a particular help for ex-smokers and asthmatics; the programme also resonates with Dementia care residents.

www.singingforseniors.co.nz was founded after seven years of research into the New Zealand aged care market by Harmonic Health; The typical sector challenges singing for seniors was designed to overcome include the following;

- ➤ Limited on-site knowledge in the facility of how to enhance physical health through singing.
- Music was seen as entertainment, the health benefits, and how to achieve these, was not clear to those responsible for activities.
- ➤ As a result retirement facilities were missing a major opportunity to improve the health and well being of residents.
- Aggregated data about how singing was being utilised was limited to non existent, so operations teams faced a challenge to implement standardised affiliated health strategies.
- ➤ Face-to-face expertise for music therapy is high cost & had limited acceptance by facilities manager, or limited use.
- Facilities were using multiple forms of music, many of which were not suited to senior's voices.
- ➤ Buy-in of staff for the programme is critical for its success, so it had to be simple to use and fun for residents, and flexible based on the facilities requirements. Facilities needed flexibility and the ability to choose a solution that meet their own needs.
- ➤ Services needed to be available independent of the location of resources, which, outside of the main centres was often difficult to find. Music therapy can be high cost in a 1:1 context and there are limited therapists, especially outside the main centres.
- ➤ Facilities managers and group management required a trusted source for programme implementation and new ideas.
- ➤ On-going training is critical to ensure staff activate the health benefits in residents and management education is critical for adoption in the facility.
- Internet technology offered the ability to lower costs, but had to match the many different user groups skills levels. This means resources had to be out-of-the-box and straight forward to use for anyone including volunteers.
- ➤ By up-skilling existing staff, tracking and monitoring their progress enabled facilities to improve their programme simply and cost effectively.
- ➤ Villages with mature programmes required new ideas regularly because existing resources did not extend the residents and to challenge them with singing, or community involvement.
- ➤ There were limited 'new' unique songs being released in the seniors category.
- > Traditional entertainment or DVD's in market did not encourage the sing-along.
- ➤ Reliance on volunteers for piano or entertainment could mean months between singing sessions due to unforeseen changes in circumstances.

Singing for Seniors offers the power of a skilled professional onsite, anytime you choose - but without the costs. There's a consistent high standard across all villages, independent of existing level of staff experience. We include on-going comprehensive training for staff and managers, as buy in at a facility level is critical.

Scalable, User Friendly Resources

We provide all of the materials 'out of the box' to implement the programme; from set-up guidelines to ongoing implementation and support. Our resources are designed for the aged care sector to be user friendly. Singing for Seniors is designed for national deployment in a group model. We have a proven deployment model with facilities in Taupo, Whangarei, Hamilton, Rotorua, Christchurch, Gisborne, Auckland and New Plymouth utilising the programme.

We leverage Internet technology to keep the costs of affiliated health care services affordable. Training and mentoring is designed to up-skill existing staff and educate facility to ensure consistency and continual improvement. This occurs via a combination of CD/DVD's, site visits and online training which would be delivered via the Internet or your Intranet. We manage regional representatives to ensure facilities get the best of online training and/or hands on training as required. Unit standards for singing therapy training are added to your staff development programmes and we provide facility managers with KPI tracking for occupational therapists & activities co-ordinators.

Flexible model focused on generating facility buy-ir

Facilities choose their own plans, or you can deploy a standard set of resources to each facility. We provide a facility based cost structure which can scale up or down based on a facilities individual requirements. This means Singing for seniors offers a low cost scalable solution.

Each village starts out with a sample disc with two songs to allow Singing for Seniors to accurately assess the current skill level. Because buy-in from the facility is critical we offer a free trial so that the facility can trial the product with it's residents before making any commitment.

The minimum requirement in the village to operate the programme is being able to operate a CD player, activities coordinators don't even have to sing. By disc three the singing for seniors programme rolled out across all of your villages will have at least 3 x higher resident participation than exercise classes, with all the benefits of exercise (except fall prevention).

All inclusive in the programme, every two months, a CD (or DVD) is provided with songs that are pitched lower, and slower – designed for seniors voices. Staff are provided training and singing programme implementation and technical support, via access to the e-learning modules based on their specific needs. Alternatively our regional representatives may visit your facility to kick start a programme, to provide an on-site unit standard assessment, or facilitate the community integration model (Christmas CD or 8-80.)

Over time songs are included that are designed to stretch voices and memory, so staff will not need the experience to determine song selection. We do encourage residents to participate and feedback into future track selection.
